
Mission Statement as of May 2013

Based on discipline data, Collins seeks to decrease the number of student behavior referrals monthly. The high number of referrals is relative to students' academic performance in that the correlation between time spent outside the classroom mirrors low academic achievement resulting in students performing below grade level as measured by the college readiness standards. Additionally, Collins seeks to identify students (without discipline issues), who struggle academically in order to provide non-evasive academic interventions and supports.
Guaranteed & Viable Curriculum: Balanced Literacy	Based on 2012 Spring EPAS data, Collins' areas of growth lie in Reading Comprehension, Word Analysis and English .
Shared Responsibility for Achievement: Professional Development	With the upcoming transition from Illinois State Standards to Common Core State Standards, all instructional staff will need to be trained in using the CCSS in order to create grade level, content-specific scope and sequence for the academic school year and weekly lesson plans. Teachers will be trained to effectively analyze formal and informal data in order to prepare instructional plans for enrichment and reteaching by utilizing data obtained from assessments aligned to the CCSS through vertical collaboration in cluster and grade level meetings.
