**Mission Statement as of May 2013**

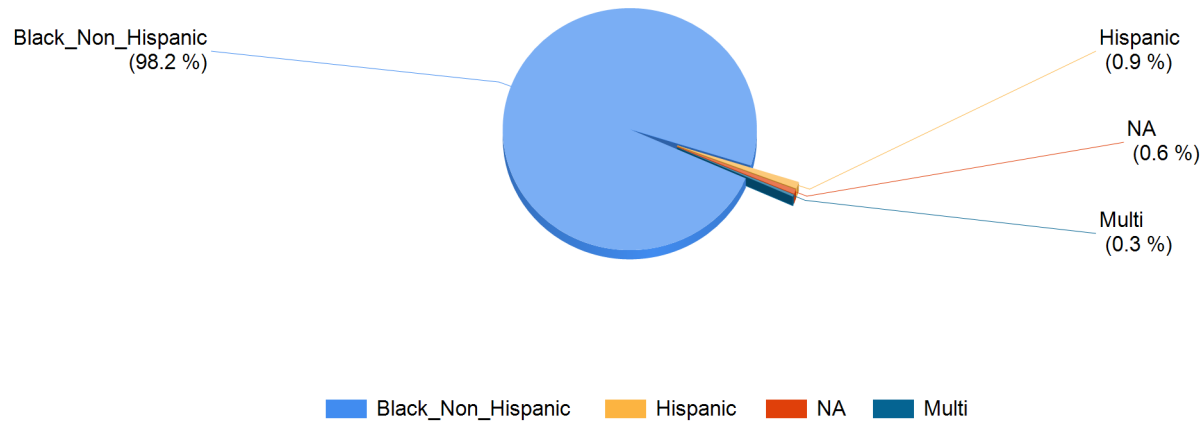
