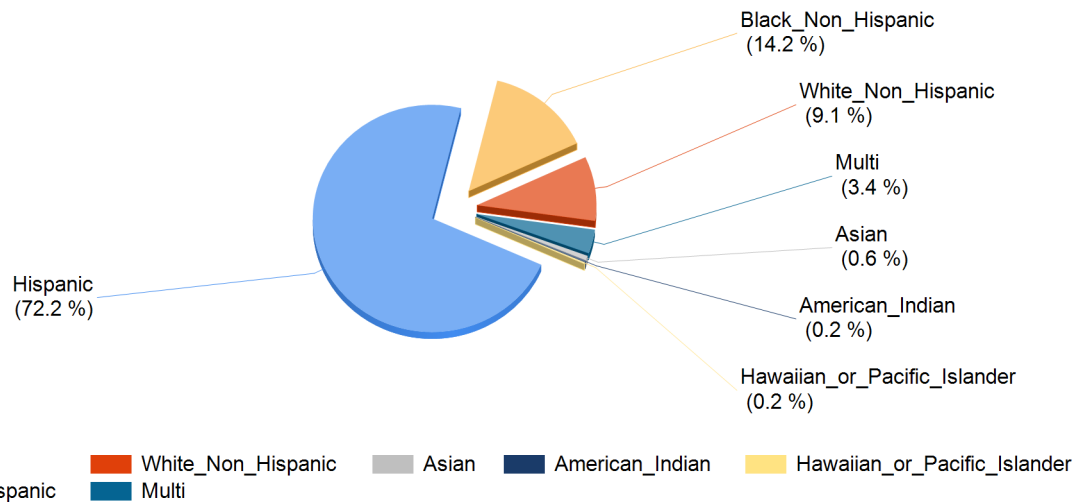
School Priorities as of May 2013

Description	Rationale
Literacy - Implement an inquiry-based balanced literacy program aligned with the Common Core State Standards (CCSS).	We have a need to implement a rigorous inquiry-based literacy curriculum as we have only 75% of all students meeting or exceeding the state standards.
Common Core - Implement Common Core State Standards in an inquiry-based curriculum for literacy, mathematics, and science.	We have a need to implement a rigorous inquiry-based literacy and mathematics curriculum as we only have 75% in reading and 85% in math of all students meeting or exceeding the state standards. When the CCSS for science are released, Jahn will integrate them with their inquiry-based learning strategies.
World Language - Create an inquiry-based, rigorous curriculum which is aligned with WIDA and ACTFL standards and second language acquisition principles.	Jahn School is revising and strengthening its schoolwide World Language curriculum in order to align to WIDA second language acquisition standards and the ACTFL standards. By improving our inquiry-based curriculum resources and methods, there will be more accountability towards what is taught at each language proficiency level and we will further support our students in acquiring the Spanish language.
