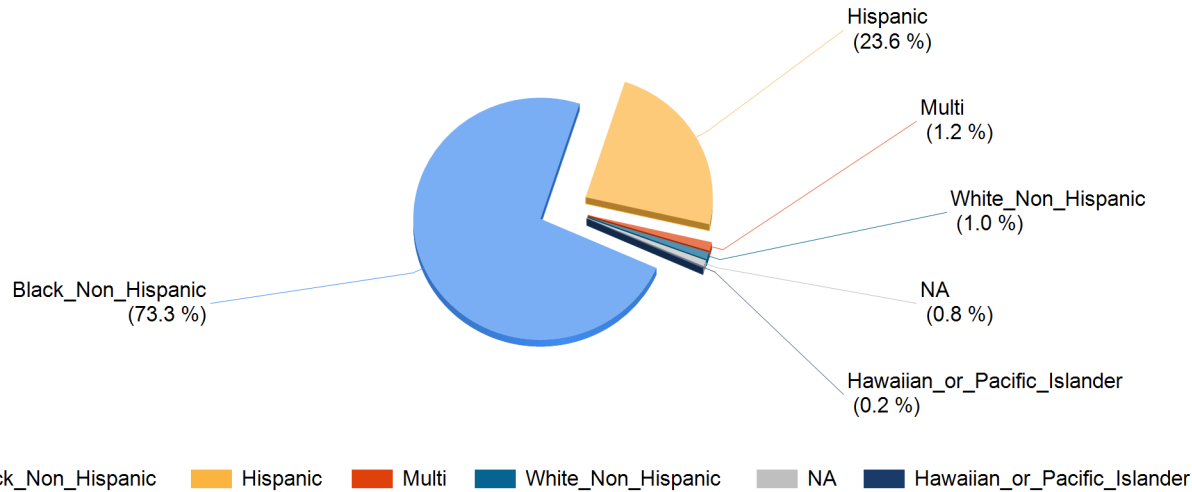
**School Priorities as of May 2013**

Description	Rationale
All building teachers understand the shifts of practice the Common Core Standards require, and use that knowledge to develop interdisciplinary Common Core aligned units for the entire school year using universal design principles.	Schoolwide, fewer than 25% of our students meet national grade level standards. Therefore we need to implement stronger curriculum in order to narrow the achievement gap and have our students career and college ready.
Our school will use summative, formative, and performance-based assessment more effectively to boost student achievement.	In the School Effectiveness Framework we rated our school as a 2 in both assessment and in monitoring and adjusting. A schoolwide focus on all types of assessment will help us monitor ourselves more thoroughly and provide more targeted feedback to students and families so that we raise student achievement.
Bring our attendance rate to 95%.	Our SY2011 attendance rate was 90.3%. Our current data shows improvement, but we continue to need to focus on this area to achieve 95%.
