

We need to ensure our students are well prepared to meet the academic rigor of the curriculum. Learning environments need to enhance instruction and support and resources for ongoing and meaningful professional development need to be established. The Excecutive Functioning system needs to be reinforced PK-12 to support organization, self-regulation, self-monitoring, and brain based techniques for student support. Student support was identified in the My School, My Voice survey, an assessment with Rush-Neuobehavioral Center, and a report generated by the Asia Society after a three-year site visit during December of 2011.
Increase active participation of the parents and community to support our instructional program and enhance the programmatic needs of the school.	As an international school, we must ensure that our parents and community are directly involved with the school's activities and enhance our instructional program. Through several parent meetings, parents have expressed a desire to be more included in the development of an international school.
