
Mission Statement as of May 2013

While the science ACT subscore is consistently the highest, the growth from EXPLORE to ACT is consistently the lowest. By improving the alignment and assessments, students should grow at an increased pace.
Teachers will deliver math instruction aligned to the Common Core and CRS (where applicable) supported by high quality open ended questions as well as traditional problems.	The math ACT subscore has consistently attained the second lowest growth from EXPLORE to ACT. By improving the alignment and assessments, students should grow at an increased pace.
Teachers will effectively use Discipline in the Secondary Classroom and Foundations techniques as part of a whole school PBIS model.	Anecdotally, the more consistently my teachers implement these practices, the more engaged the students become. Cuuricular pacing has increased in these classrooms and at the same time, the teachers are seeing greater achievement on student assessments. These initiatives are also positively affecting general student behavior. Student tardiness is down, negative student interaction is down. These initiatives need to be moved from pockets in the school to school-wide endeavors.
