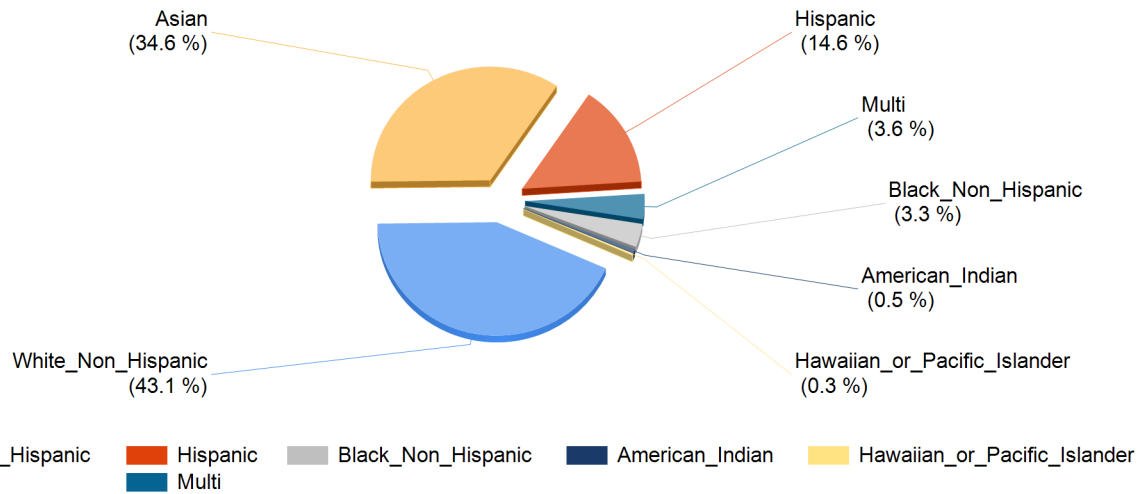
### School Priorities as of May 2013

Description	Rationale
Increase percentage of students exceeding in Reading in grades 3 - 8 with a focus on 4th and 8th grade	For the past 3 years the percentage of students in 4th grade in the exceeds category has declined in reading. Although the 8th grade scores in the exceeds category has increased over the past 3 years, growth has not been commensurate with other grades.
Increase percentage of students exceeding in Science in grades 4 & 7	93% of students meet or exceed in Science, but only 37.1% of students in grades 4 & 7 exceed in Science.
Teachers to align curriculum to Common Core State Standards	Teachers need to prepare students to become college and career ready and to prepare them for the 2014 PARCC exam.
