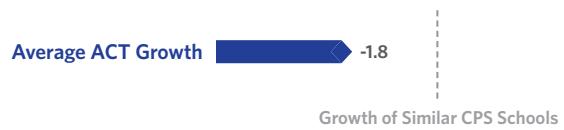

## Student Growth



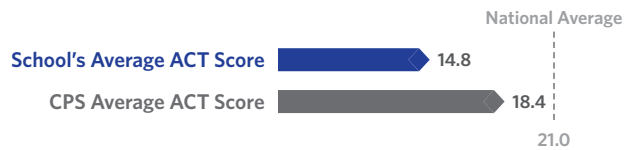

## Student Attainment



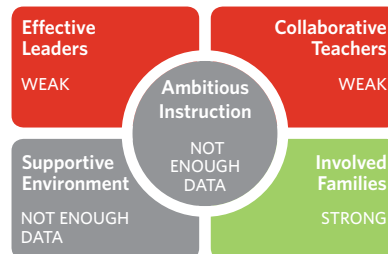
Student Attainment at this school was far below average, which means ACT scores in Spring 2016 were much lower than the national average score.

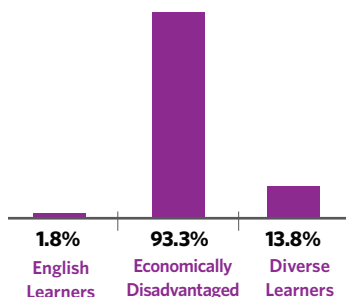

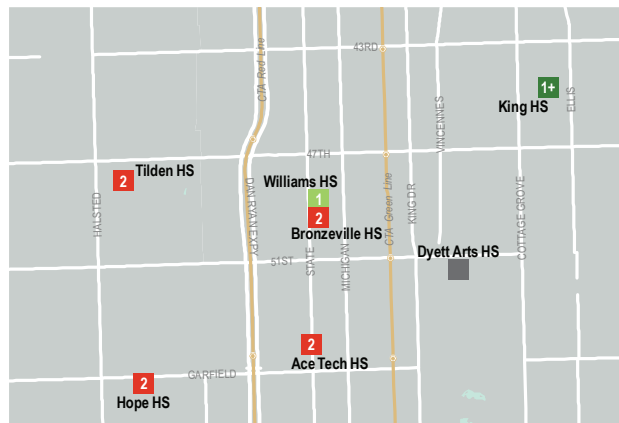

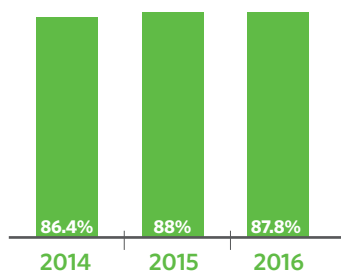
## Neighborhood Map

Students' reported sense of membership in the school community on the 5Essentials survey

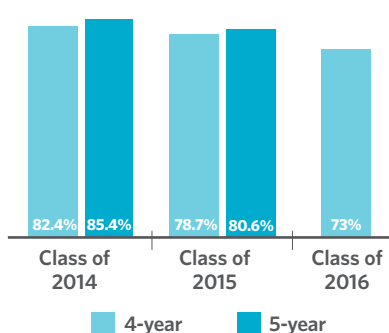
