This plan will expand the newer High Definition camera system to the 37 high risk High Schools. These schools were identified by the Chicago Police Department and the Office of School Safety and Security as High Risk based on CPD and CPS incident data. The existing camera systems at CPS have proven to be ineffective and sufficient for meeting the security and investigative requirements and demands dictated by the school's environment. The Office of School Safety and Security, The Office of Emergency Management and Communications and the Chicago Police Department all require a camera system that will provide a greater forensic value through quality images and greater physical surveillance coverage with the addition of new High Definition cameras and a standard camera platform. The current camera systems at our schools are not robust enough to meet this need.
