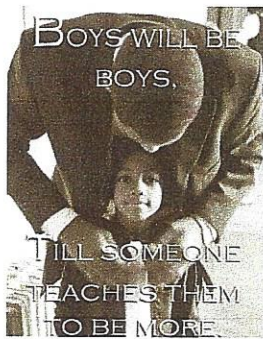

Kemet Leadership Academy for Boys of Color At Englewood High School – 6203 S. Stewart

Bold. Innovative. Powerful! Sustainable Black Male Achievement is critical to our future success and for combating the plagues of drugs, gangs and gun influences on our men, women and children. Changing outcomes starts with breaking the school to prison pipeline. Currently 40% of Black Boys drop out of high school as opposed to graduating. With high unemployment, lack of options and under-educated, jail and recidivism is a foregone conclusion. To change community conditions, we must change the traditional education paradigm into one that will transform potentially lost boys into productive and powerful men.

Kemet Leadership Academy Charter School is for 5th to 8th grade boys who are not excelling in the traditional CPS elementary school, making them likely candidates to drop out of high school and to continue the school to prison pipeline. Kemet is also for boys needing strong male role models and opportunities to express themselves differently than normally afforded at home or at school. Our school model is Competency Based Education; using Blended Learning techniques of collaboration, technology, independent learning and guided practice. Students will learn based on mastery of skills, using core subject content as a vehicle and not the end-all, as in traditional education models.

The Kemet Leadership Academy as planned for the Englewood High School building; includes strong wrap-around student and family support services, co-curriculum <mandated> sports and activities, integrated community services (job placement, housing development, and parent workshops). BUT, we need your help.

Kemet is proposed to occupy the space soon to be vacated by Team Englewood High School. We would be co-tenants with Urban Prep Academies High School and together this building would serve as a focal point for Black Male Achievement. Graduates of Kemet would not only be ready for high school; but we will prep them for vocational success and other career paths. Our goal is long term success based on each student's individual path in life. Partners include:
