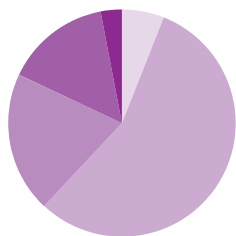

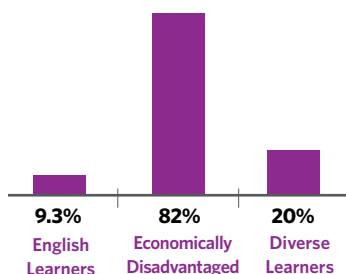

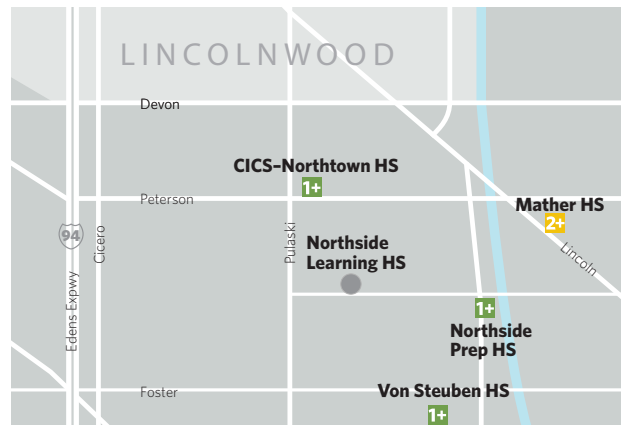

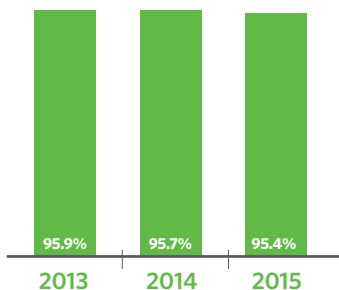
## Neighborhood Map



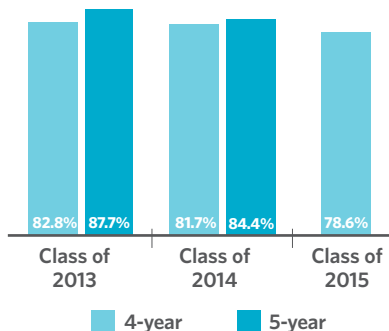

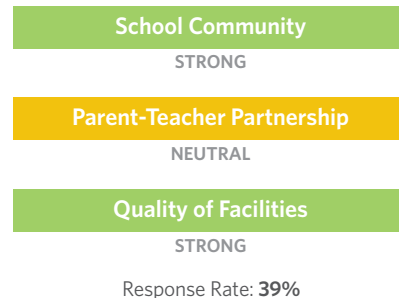

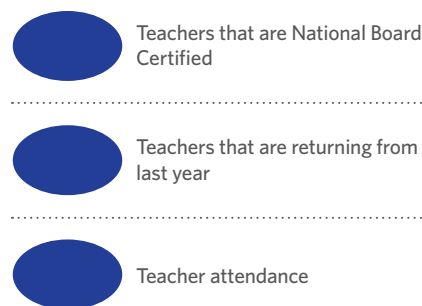
