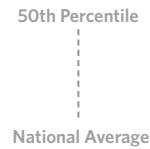

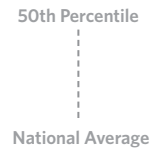


## Student Attainment



Student Attainment at this school was below average, which means ACT scores in Spring 2015 were lower than the national average score.

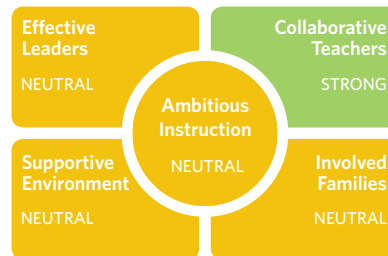
ACT Average Score **14th**

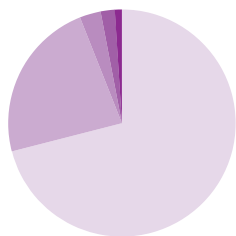

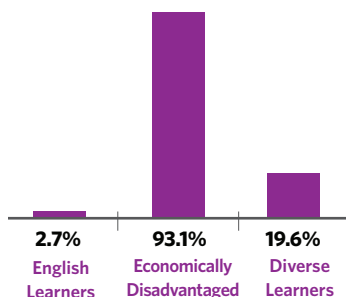

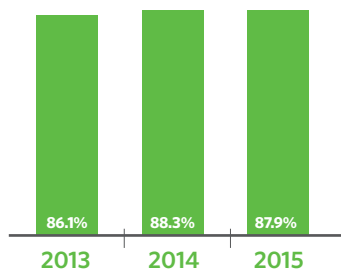
## Neighborhood Map

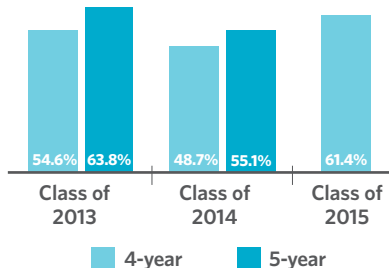
