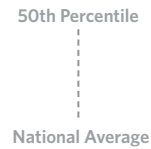

ACT Average Growth ▶

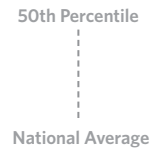

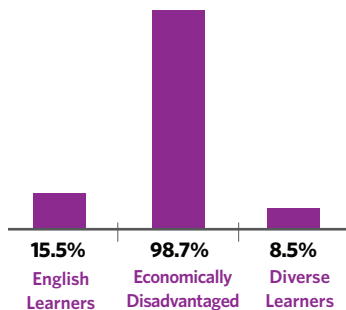

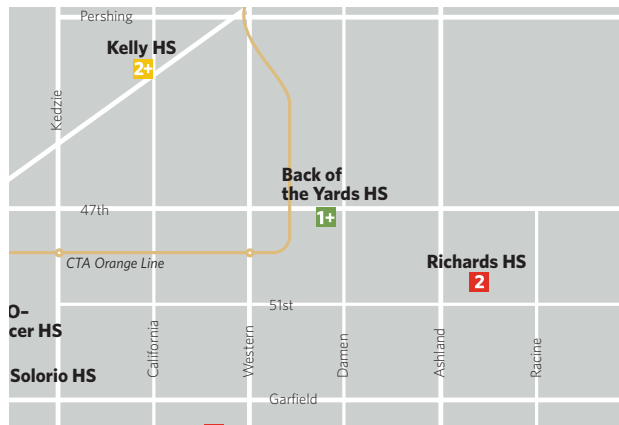

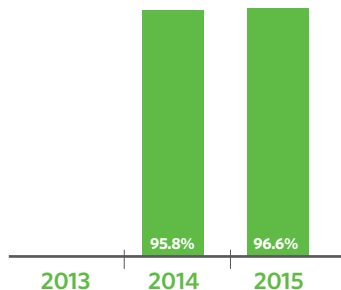
## Neighborhood Map

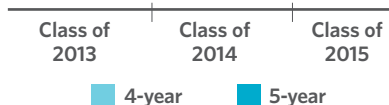
