
## **Students Making Growth Targets**




Students Making Growth Targets is the percent of students who reached the 40th percentile growth on STAR. This school has a moderate number students reaching this level of growth.







90% attendance or have improved by at least 3 percentage points





#### Suspension Practices The percent of students who received one or more out-of-school suspensions
